# The Somalia-Born Community in Victoria — 2016 Census (ranked 64)



#### **Demographic characteristics**

At the 2016 Census, there were 3,904 Somalia-born persons in Victoria (50.9% of Australia's total), ranked 64<sup>th</sup> among the overseas-born communities in Victoria. The Somalia-born increased by 27.5% (843) from 3,061 persons in 2011. They are distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with concentrations in the LGAs of Melbourne (13.9%), Banyule (12.6%), Hume (10.8%), Wyndham (10.0%) and Darebin (8.2%).

The Somalia-born reflected an adult to balanced age profile: 20.7% were aged 25 years and under; 50.3% were aged 26-44; 24.8% were aged 45-64; and 4.3% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 36 years, compared to 37 years for total Victoria. The gender ratio was 81 males to 100 females, compared to 96 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

There were 8,417 persons identified with Somali ancestry. Most of them were born in Somalia (40.8%), Australia (40.1%), New Zealand (4.7%), Kenya (4.3%) and Ethiopia (2.2%). One-fifth (20.8%) of the Somalia-born in Victoria had arrived in Australia prior to 1996; 25.8% arrived in 1996-2000; 14.4% arrived in 2001-2005; 14.7% arrived in 2006-2010; and 19.2% arrived in 2011-2016.

Most of the Somalia-born speak Somali (89.2%) and Arabic (2.6%); 3.8% speak English only. Of those who speak a language other than English, 16.7% speak English not well/not at all. Most (93.8%) of the Somalia-born are Muslim; 1.1% have no religion. Seventy per cent (70.0%) of Somalia-born have Australian citizenship, compared to 58.3% for overseas-born in Victoria.







#### **Economic characteristics**

The education levels of the Somalia-born are lower than those for total Victoria. Less of them (2.5%) have a postgraduate degree and a bachelor degree (10.9%), compared to 16.5% and 1.0% for Victoria. More of the Somalia-born (14.5%) have an advanced diploma or diploma or no educational attainment (8.7%), compared to 9.2% and 1.0% for Victoria.

The labour force participation rate of the Somalia-born at 55.8% is lower than that of total Victoria at 60.5%. Their unemployment rate at 24.58% is significantly higher than for total Victoria at 6.6%.

The occupational patterns of the Somalia-born are different from those for total Victoria. The Somalia-born are under-represented in most occupations, with some exceptions: 31.2% are community & personal service workers and 22.6% are machinery operators & drivers, compared to 10.6% and 5.8% for Victoria.

The industry of employment patterns of the Somalia-born are also different to those for total Victoria. The Somalia-born are again underrepresented in most industries, with some exceptions: 18.9% are employed in transport, postal & warehousing and 38.0% are employed in health care & social assistance, compared to 4.8% and 12.5% for Victoria.

The weekly personal income distribution pattern for the Somalia-born is lower than for total Victoria. More of the Somalia-born receive \$1-\$399 (35.0%) and \$400-\$799 (26.2%), compared to 20.1% and 23.1% for Victoria. Less of them receive \$800-\$1,249 (12.7%), \$1,250-\$1,999 (5.3%) and \$2,000 or more (1.6%), compared to 16.7, 13.6% and 7.5% for Victoria.
