1 Objective

The objective of these Regulations is to prescribe fees for the purposes of the **Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1996**.

2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 59 of the **Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1996**.

3 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 21 September 2019.

4 Definitions

In these Regulations, *the Act* means the **Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1996**.

5 Fees

For the purposes of the Act, the fees are those set out in Schedule 1.
