Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Act 2007

FEES UNDER SECTION 73

I, Lily D'Ambrosio, Minister for Energy and Resources, on and from 1 July 2023 –

1. revoke any fees fixed under section 73 of the **Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Act 2007** (VEET Act) prior to the date of this notice; and
2. fix the following pursuant to section 73 of the VEET Act and the regulations made under it, including the Victorian Energy Efficiency Target Regulations 2018 (VEET Regulations) and the Victorian Energy Efficiency Target (Project-Based Activities) Regulations 2017 (PBA Regulations).

Application for registration of a certificate (section 22(3)(b) of the VEET Act) (note: the application for registration may also be referred to as creation).	\$1.00
Application for accreditation (Section 9(1)(a) of the VEET Act).	\$3,000
Application for renewal of accreditation (section 9(1)(b) of the VEET Act).	\$1,000
Application for approval of a project impact report, where there has been no prior approval of an application for a project impact report for the project (regulation 11 of the PBA Regulations).	\$500
Application to list a product on the ESC Register (regulation 32 of the VEET Regulations).	\$500
Lodgement of an energy acquisition statement (section 33 of the VEET Act).	\$3,122
Request for reconsideration of a reviewable decision (section 56 of the VEET Act).	\$750

3. Notify industry of my intention to fix the following additional fees on and from 1 November 2023 –

Description of Fee	Fee
Fee for creation of, and notification to determine registration of, a certificate (section 22 of the VEET Act)	\$2.33
Late lodgement of an application for renewal of accreditation	\$13,814
Application to open a VEET scheme registry account	\$2,000
Application for variation of conditions of accreditation	\$1,500

4. Make the following provisions for the reduction, waiver or refund of the fees fixed in this instrument –
 - (a) the Essential Services Commission (ESC) or an authorised officer of the ESC may, at its discretion, reduce, waiver or refund, in whole or in part, any fee;
 - (b) for the avoidance of doubt, the fee applying to certificates created prior to 1 July 2023 for which no fee has been invoiced as at 1 July 2023 is \$1.00.
